11 Hotel Information

It is advised to book a hotel in the center of Brussels, in the neighborhood of "Brussel-Centraal" (train station). The "Brussel-Centraal" train station has a direct line with the "Brussels-Airport" train station. From "Brussel-Centraal", it is possible to take either the train (recommended) or the metro to reach the university campus (about 20 minutes travel time). In addition, there are two direct train connections per hour between Brussels Airport and railway station "Etterbeek".

12 Reaching the campus by Train or Metro

The campus can be reached via:

- By train (recommended), direct line from "Brussel-Centraal" to train station "Etterbeek" (located next to building PL9). See <http://www.belgianrail.be/> for time schedules.

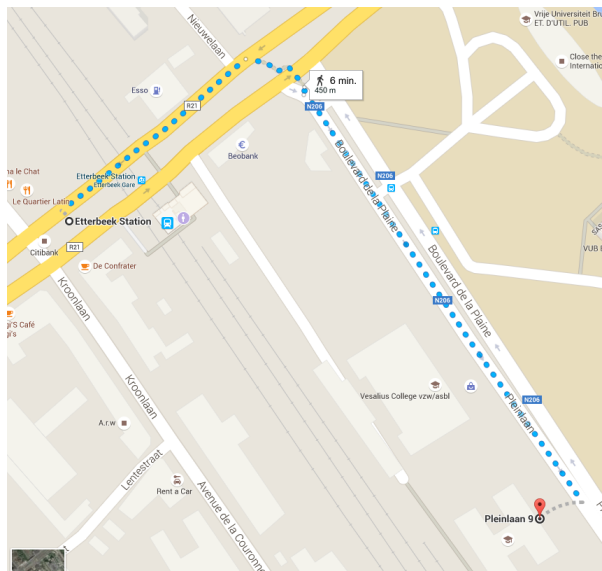


Fig. 2: Directions from Etterbeek station to building PL9.

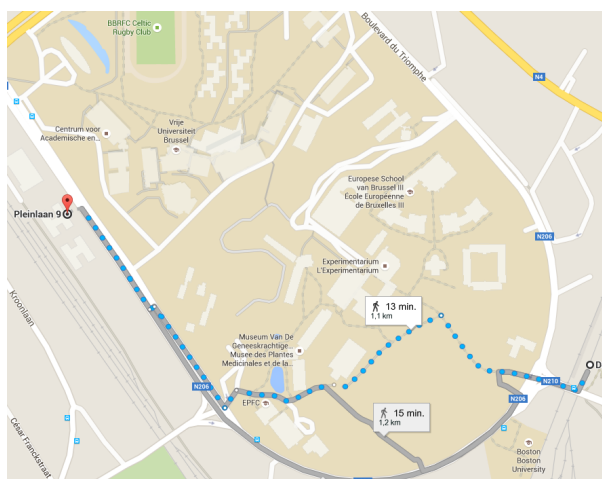


Fig. 3: Directions from Delta station to building PL9.
