Meetings on all days will be hosted by **School of Technology and Management (ESTG), Polytechnic University of Leiria** and **Instituto de Telecomunicações**.

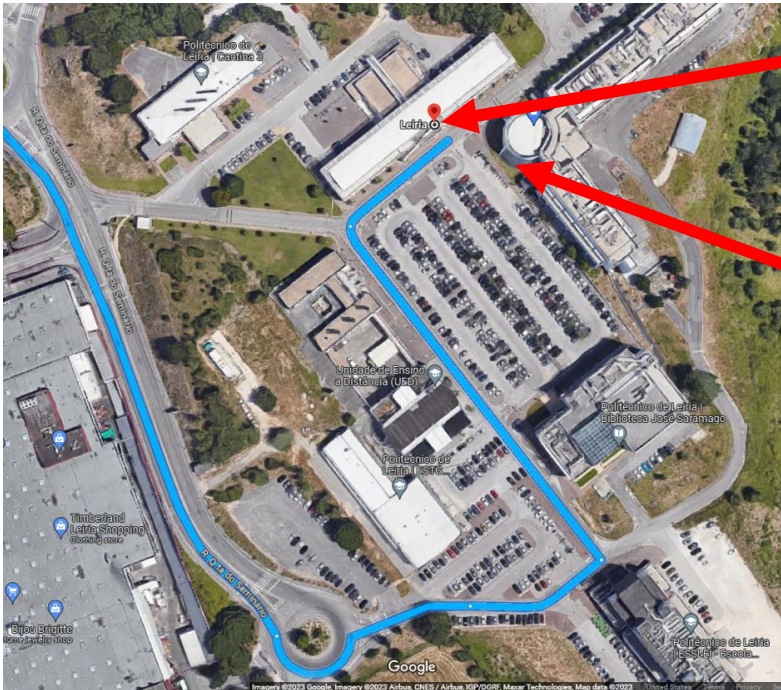

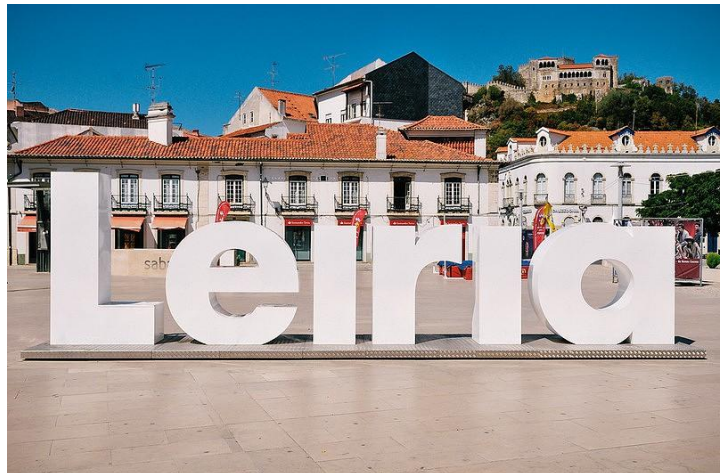

Travel Information



Leiria is located in the central region of Portugal, approximately half way from the two main cities in Portugal (Lisbon/Lisboa, and Porto), which are served by International Airports. Lisbon is slightly closer and has more international flights available.

There is no viable train option from Lisbon or Porto to Leiria, but there are several highways and regular Bus services.

Transport To and From the Airports

From Lisbon Airport

- **By Bus**

There are two main bus terminals in Lisbon, both accessible from the airport by metro:

- Sete Rios Bus Terminal (metro station: Jardim Zoológico)
- Oriente Transport Hub (metro station: Oriente)

In Leiria, there is a single central bus station.

The main bus operators are [Rede Expressos](#) and [FlixBus](#).

Rede Expressos operates from both Sete Rios and Oriente, while FlixBus departs only from Oriente. When booking tickets online, please make sure to check the departure terminal.

Buses to and from Leiria run at least once per hour. The journey typically takes between 1h45 and 2h15, depending on the number of stops (as indicated during booking). There are generally more departures from Sete Rios than from Oriente.

- **By car** – Approximately 1h30min

From Oporto Airport

- **By Bus**

There are several bus departure points in Porto, including the Airport and the main bus station Campanhã, which is easily accessible by metro and public transport.

In Leiria, there is a single central bus station.

The main bus operators are [Rede Expressos](#) and [FlixBus](#).

Both companies operate frequent services from Porto to Leiria. When booking tickets online, please confirm the departure terminal, as it may vary depending on the service.

Buses to and from Leiria run at least once per hour. The journey usually takes between 2h20 and 3h30, depending on the number of stops and the selected route (as indicated during booking).

- **By car** – Approximately 2h00

Rental Car

Car Rental services are available online and at the Lisbon and Porto Airports. Driving to and from Leiria is easy (there are highways connecting the three cities) and provides opportunities to visit interesting cities in the way to Lisbon (including Batalha, Nazaré and Óbidos) and Porto (including Coimbra and Aveiro).

Travel documents and visas

Portugal is part of the Schengen area. Visitors from most countries do not require a Visa to enter Portugal for a short-term stay not exceeding 90 days. For those passengers, a valid passport is sufficient to enter Portugal.

Currency And Credit Cards

The basic unit of currency is the Euro.

Major credit cards are widely accepted and ATMs are very commonplace throughout Portugal. There is a ATM terminal in the venue (not available on Sunday).

Time Zone

Leiria is in Western European Summer Time (WEST). During July it is summer time and WEST is UTC+1.

Climate

The average temperature in July is warm at around 25–28°C, but it can vary between approximately 17°C at night, with daytime peaks often going over 30°C. For more details check [on-line](#).

Electricity

The voltage in Germany is 230V / 50Hz with plug type F. Type C plugs, two round pins without grounding, also fit.

- Aveiro (nice city by the sea)
