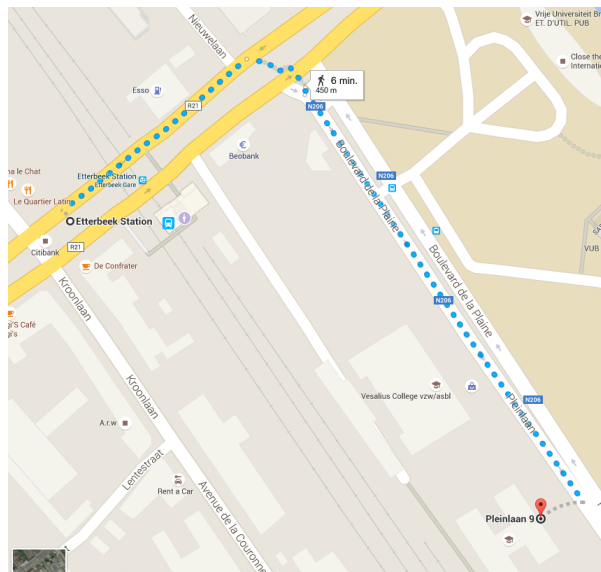


Fig. 2: Directions from Etterbeek station to building PL9.

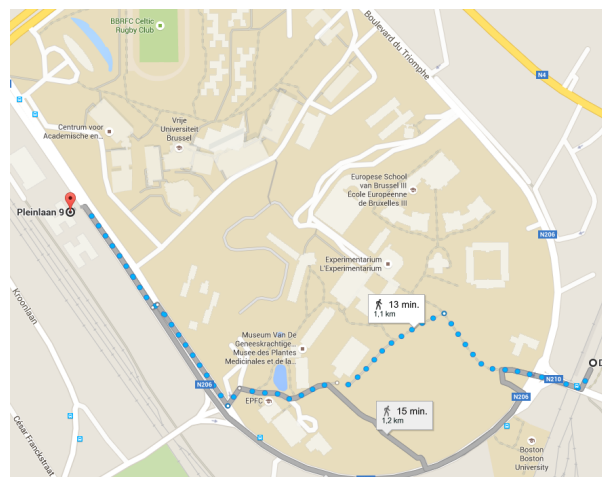


Fig. 3: Directions from Delta station to building PL9.
