89th JPEG virtual meeting calling notice

Due to COVID-19 situation, the 89th JPEG meeting which was originally planned to take place in Rennes has been replaced by an online meeting from 5 to 9 October 2020. The time zones of main meetings (JPEG plenary, subgroups plenaries, meetings requiring input and opinion from a large number of experts) will be organized at time zones following guidelines from JTC1 Standing Document 19. All other breakout sessions will be organized at time zones that will be suitable for the majority of contributors to those sessions.
