93rd JPEG virtual meeting calling notice

Due to COVID-19 situation, the 93rd JPEG meeting which was originally planned to take place in mixed mode in Berlin has been replaced by an online meeting from 18 to 22 October 2021. The time zones of main meetings (JPEG plenary, subgroups plenaries, meetings requiring input and opinion from a large number of experts) will be organized at time zones following guidelines from JTC1 Standing Document 19, a survey and after discussion between Convenor and WG 1 Subgroup chairs. All breakout sessions will be organized at time zones that will be suitable for the majority of contributors to those sessions.

All sessions are announced in advance in order to allow experts interested in participation to plan ahead. Information regarding each session will include session name, date, time (in Coordinated Universal Time - UTC), duration, chair name and contact email, objectives/activities, input and output documents, agenda and access instructions.

A first draft of the above schedule will be communicated by email to experts several days prior to the virtual meeting subject to updates until the Friday prior to the JPEG meeting week. Any further changes during the meeting will be only possible upon approval at the JPEG plenary meeting.
